



# Water/Wastewater Report

## Water Department Report

The water department produced 2,146,000 gallons of water, for a daily average of just over 69,000 gallons. Dead end main flushing was 66,000 gallons. Flushing is required by the TCEQ of all "dead end" mains.

For the month of July by comparison we produced 2,328,900 gallons of water, for an average of 75,000 gallons. June we

flushed just less than 10,000 gallons.

On July 25<sup>th</sup> the packing ring retainer broke on the South Well, making this well inoperative. Service was called and a new part is on order. This well is the smallest of the three and will be put back in service next week.

The water department replaced 5 defective or nonfunctioning meters.

There was two water leaks reported at FM17 South with an estimated 3000 gallons lost.

One water tap made on Higginbotham St.

Kenneth scheduled to take the "D" Groundwater test September 14<sup>th</sup>.

### Special points of interest:

- The month of August we had 13 inches of rain.
- Did you know we mow approximately 13 acres every week.
- An estimated 17,000 gallons of water was used for fire fighting this month.

## Wastewater Department Report

The Wastewater department treated 3.09 million gallons for the month of August. This month's DMR reported eleven flow violations that exceeded the limit of .08 MGD.

On August a sewer tap was completed on Higginbotham St.

Identified two places that customer owned sewer stoppages were cleared out.

Replaced broken manhole lid and retaining ring on FM South outfall line, warning signs will be ordered and installed.

Street repairs should start September 5<sup>th</sup> providing we can get the rolling machine from Lennon Construction.

A new small compactor was put into service to aid in street repair. It has made a difference in how

well the base and patch material stays in place.

With all the heavy rains this month we are still busy mowing every day.

Street patching on Farrington, Kirby, Annie and Mockingbird.

Kenneth is scheduled to take Wastewater class September 19<sup>th</sup>.

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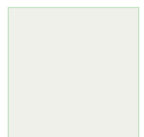
