



Water/Wastewater Report

Water Department Report

The water department produced 1,875,800 gallons of water, for a daily average of just over 62,527 gallons. Dead end main flushing was 7,862 gallons. Flushing is required by the TCEQ of all "dead end" mains.

For the month of October by comparison we produced 2,301,100 gallons of water, for an average of 74,229 gallons. September we flushed approximately 14,830 gallons.

On July 25th the packing ring retainer broke on the South Well, making this well inoperative. Service was called and a new part is on order. This well is the smallest of the three and will be put back in service when a part can be located.

There were no water leaks to report.
